

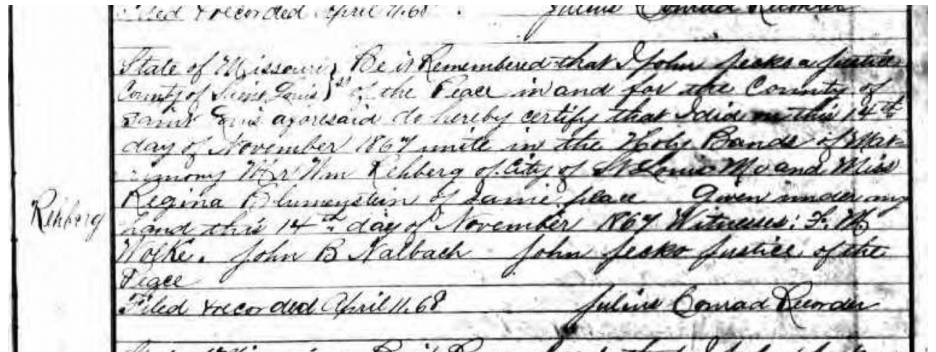

Mrs. Regina Rehberg: was listed as the head of the household in 1883. She was born on March 30th, 1846 in Germany and died at age 58 in Akron, Ohio on June 11th, 1904. Regina Blumenstein was married to William Otto August Rehberg on November 14th, 1867 and had two children, a son Charles August Rehberg and a daughter Emma Rehberg.

Charles worked as a woodcarver, presumably at The Pullman Palace Car Company. He enlisted in the U.S Army in 1899 at age 26 where he served for 3 years. He married Jennie May Ross on September 11, 1905 in Plattsburgh, New York at age 33.

Henry Antry: is listed as a boarder at this address and worked as a painter, presumably at The Pullman Palace Car Company

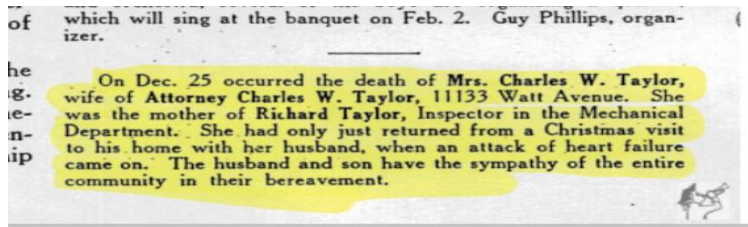
William P. Sievert: is listed as a boarder at this address but his birth, death, and occupation at the time are unknown.

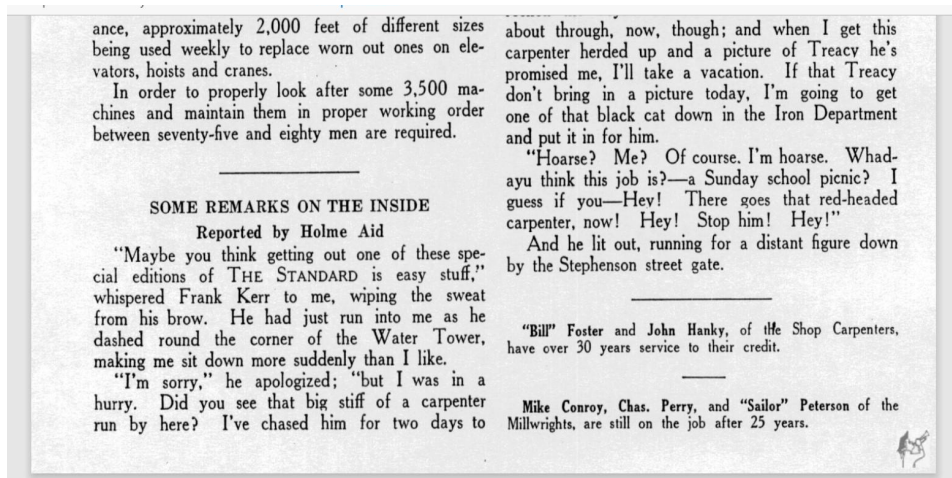

whose subject he has heretofore been. Conroy

And the said petitioner further represents that he has ever since continued to reside within the jurisdiction of the United States; that he has never borne any hereditary title, or been of any of the orders of nobility; that he is ready to renounce and abjure all allegiance and fidelity to every foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatsoever; and particularly to Victoria, Queen of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,

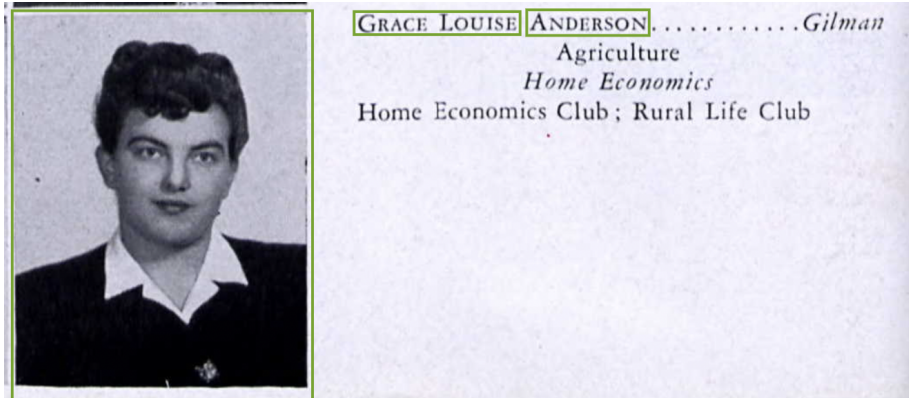

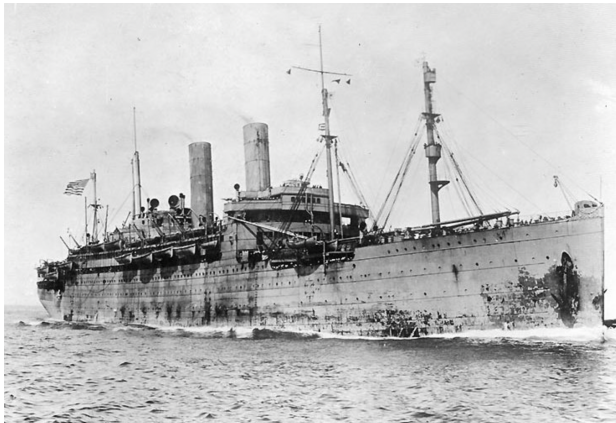
The 1940 and 1950 Federal Census list the same family of five as the residents of this address.

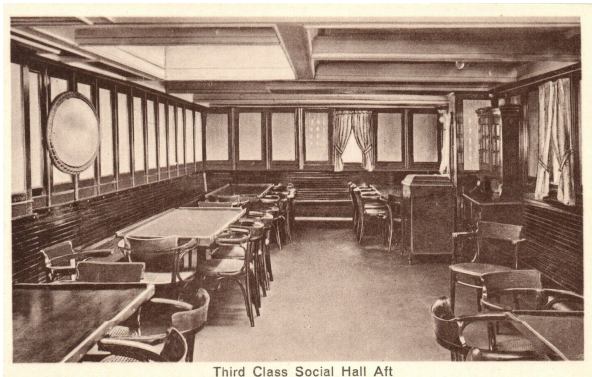

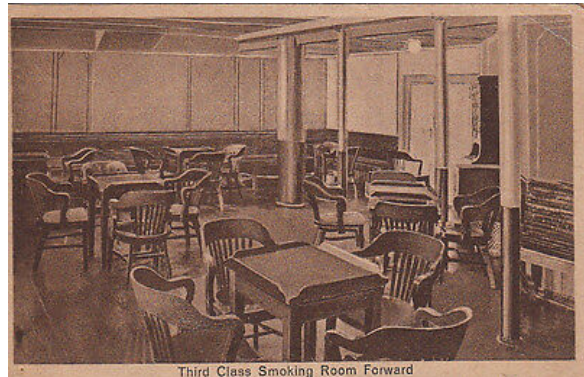


SS George Washington 1920

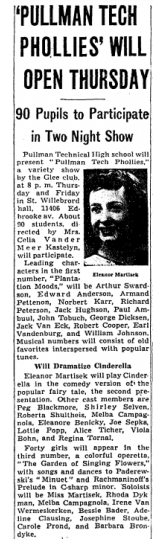
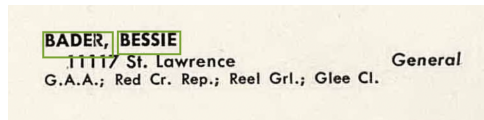

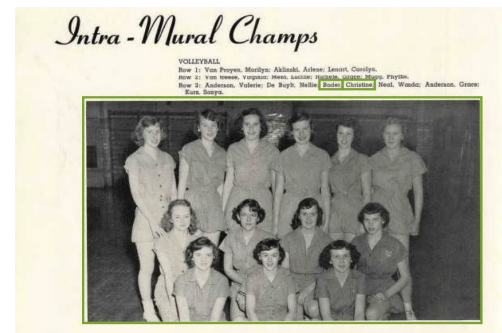

Fenger Academy Choir 1950

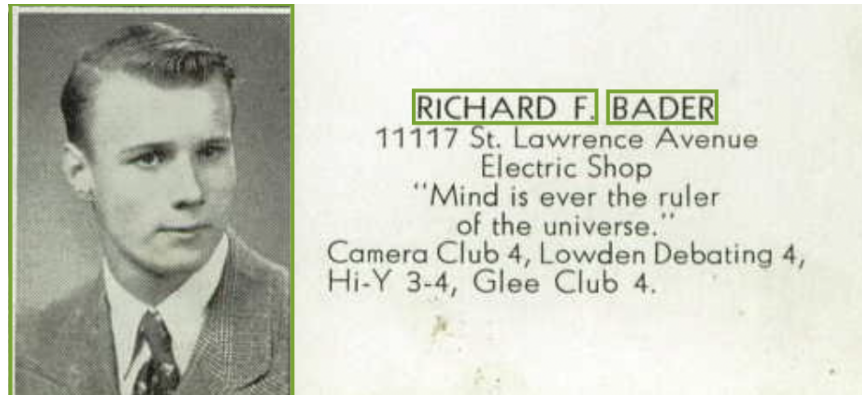
